INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

Dwelling Burglary (4)

There were four burglaries in Ashurst on the same day. These happened during the day time while the occupants were out. Jewellery and electrical items were among the items stolen.

Non-Dwelling Burglary (5)

A hotel was broken into overnight in Lyndhurst and a TV and till were stolen.

Tools were stolen from a cattle shed in Netley Marsh and a garage was broken into in Lyndhurst.

Criminal Damage (4)

A woman has been arrested after a window was smashed at Ashurst Hospital.

As a result of a domestic incident in Woodlands a car was damaged. Three men have been arrested in connection with this incident.

Theft from Motor Vehicle (2)

A handbag was stolen from a vehicle which had been left unlocked outside Foxhills School. Please remember to lock your vehicles and remove all valuables.

Theft (1)

A trailer was stolen overnight outside the owner's home in Lyndhurst.

Assault (1)

A local man was assaulted by two men when he was on his way home. Fortunately he did not sustain any serious injuries.
