Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Targeting crime and Anti-Social behaviour

### Total incidents reported: Ashurst – 16 of which 7 were crimes. Lyndhurst - 27 of which 7 were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

#### **Anti-social behaviour** – Ashurst (0).

Lyndhurst (1) A female reported nuisance communications.

**Assaults** – Ashurst (2) A male was assaulted by an associate and another was domestic related. Lyndhurst (0).

**Burglary** – Ashurst (0). Lyndhurst (0). *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

**Burglary (non dwelling)** – Ashurst (2) Two commercial premise were broken in to. Lyndhurst (0). *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

**Criminal Damage** – Ashurst (0). Lyndhurst (0).

**Drugs** – Ashurst (0) Lyndhurst (2) A male was in a forest car park in possession of cannabis and another male was found in possession of a Class A drug.

**Public Order** – (0)

**Road traffic collisions** – Ashurst (0). Lyndhurst (2) Both involved minor injuries.

**Road traffic incidents** – Ashurst (1) A male was summonsed for speeding on Lyndhurst Road. Lyndhurst (3) A male was reported for having no insurance and two were summonsed for speeding on Chapel Lane.

**Theft** – Ashurst (2) Earthing cable was stolen from a power line and a vehicle was stolen from outside a pub. Lyndhurst (3) There were three thefts from commercial buildings.

**Theft from vehicles** – Ashurst (1) A number plate was stolen from a vehicle in Woodlands. Lyndhurst (1) A wallet and contents were stolen from an unattended vehicle in a forest car park. *Please ensure you secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

**Other incidents** – After great work by the Acquisitive Crime Team at Lyndhurst two males from the Salisbury area have been charged with 34 offences of conspiracy to steal from motor vehicle in the Forest area between August and December 2013, many of these were in local car parks.
